Sunday Masses will resume on the weekend of June 20/21, 2020.

Please note the following:

1. To comply with the requirement of 30% capacity and to maintain a safe physical distance of 2 metres among the congregation, the church can only accommodate 100 people for Mass. Additional seating for 80 people will be provided in the church hall where Mass will be livestreamed and Holy Communion will be distributed. Parishioners are asked to reserve their seats on line at <https://www.eventbrite.ca/e/109551328974> or by phone at 905-568-8939. When booking by phone, please provide clearly your name, phone number, date and time of Mass and number of attendees.
2. Parishioners are asked to self-screen before attending church, including taking their temperature. Those with a temperature at or above 37.8C, who feel unwell (such as exhibiting symptoms of cough, fever or respiratory ailment), or who have been in contact with Covid-19 patients, should not attend Mass and are advised to seek medical attention promptly. The Archbishop continues to provide dispensation from the Sunday Mass obligation for those who are not able to attend for health reasons or due to capacity restrictions. They can attend Mass livestreamed from St. Michael's Cathedral or any Mass offered through other channels.
3. Parishioners are asked to enter the church through the main door and exit through the side doors or the emergency exits on both sides of the altar. Upon arrival at the church narthex, please follow the directions of the ushers and enter the church while maintaining the 2 m/6 ft physical distance. Seating is marked by green tape on the pews. Please sanitize your hands before entering and wear masks at all times. Please bring your own masks.
4. Offertory baskets are placed at the front and back of the church. Parishioners can deposit their monetary offerings in the baskets as they leave the church after Mass.
5. To avoid surface contact, all prayer books and hymnals have been removed from the pews. Holy water fonts will remain empty.
6. The Sign of Peace will be conveyed by a simple bow of the head.
7. Holy Communion will be received in the hand only. Physical distance is to be maintained while going up to receive Holy Communion. After receiving the Eucharist in the hand, the communicant will step aside, remove the mask and place the Eucharist in the mouth.



8. The Sacrament of Reconciliation will be administered in the chapel. Anyone wishing to receive the sacrament should inform the priest and wait outside the chapel. Penitents must wear masks during confession.
9. Members of the faithful who wish to offer Mass are asked to send in their requests and monetary offering to the parish office at least one week in advance, stating the date and intention of the Mass.
10. The parish office is closed for the time being. Please contact the secretary through the office side door if necessary.
11. Please refrain from using the elevator and washrooms at this time. Only one person at a time is allowed in the elevator or washroom. Parishioners are requested to leave the church immediately after Mass and avoid socializing in the church premises.

I thank you all for your patience and understanding. As the pandemic is not yet over, we must remain vigilant and observe all safety precautions. Let us care for one another, and place our hope and trust in the Lord. May his peace be with us all! God bless!
